WATER INGRESS AND INSURANCE CLAIMS

This month has been filled with paperwork and visits from insurance assessors. But still no progress on getting rectification works done. We have our third round of assessors visits this Wednesday morning, then we wait 2-3 weeks for their reports and recommendations, which get sent to the insurance company, not to us. We are not permitted to appoint our builders to do any work, we must use the insurance companies preferred contractors. This is a slow, time consuming and tedious path that we are required to follow.

Brisbane is currently in a unique position. Southern real estate markets have started to cool with prices starting to stall or even drop, but Brisbane is still showing signs of growth (although at a reduced rate, but still in a positive direction). We have just had our recent March sales record of \$1.2m for a villa topped by a sale in April of a three-bedroom unit in the complex selling for \$1.3M, which is an excellent result for our complex. The unit sold at the first open home.

Rental demand continues to outstrip supply with properties being rented within a few days of being advertised at record weekly rents. The construction next door having limited impact on the demand for our product. In May 100% of expiring leases opted to resign at increased weekly rents.
